Grading Policy for Judoka with a disability or disabilities

Criteria:

"The judoka is disabled, which is any long lasting and serious personal participation problem, caused by the interaction between a functional disorders, mental, intellectual, physical, motorial or censorial activities in executing personal and external factors."

Grading up to and

including 1st Kyu. In recognition of special needs Judoka, Grade Examiners can use their own discretion and good judgment within the spirit of the Judo when issuing Kyu grades to Judoka wit h a disability or disabilities.
