Aim

The ACT points system helps in the development of competitive Judo players and to ensure that local competitions are well attended. It is also used to determine Judo ACT end of year awards for best athlete in each age category.

- To receive place points a competitor must win a fight.
- When selected to represent Australia and endorsed by Judo Australia, competitors will receive 2 points for each category eg. 2 points for Cadets and 2 points for Junior Men if at the same competition.
- When selected to represent Australia and endorsed by Judo Australia, competitors who medal in international competitions will receive Tier 2 points.
- Competitors in the above Opens will receive the following points if there are less than **8** competitors in their division:
1st 6 points, 2nd 4 points, 3rd 2 points, participation 1 point.
